

IIT students win Young Engineer and Scientist's award, get internship offer in Japan

Students from six IITs– Bombay, Madras, Kharagpur, Kanpur, Roorkee and Delhi were rewarded with US \$3,000 each



Around 14 students from the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) were recently awarded with the Young Engineer and Scientist's (Y-E-S) award 2019-20.

Students belonging to the six IITs– Bombay, Madras, Kharagpur, Kanpur, Roorkee and Delhi were rewarded with US \$3,000 each along with an internship programme at a company or research institute in Japan for 10 weeks. The internship programme will further offer US \$7,000 to the awardees.

The students are directed to utilise the reward only for pursuing education or skill development.

The Y-E-S award is conducted by Honda Cars India Ltd (HCL) to honour students from IITs after a thorough evaluation by a jury of senior Honda executives and prominent Indian scientists. The awards were initiated by the Honda Foundation in 2007 with an aim to nurture young students who have excelled in the area of science and technology and aspire for higher academic achievement.
